SERMON DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. In the moment of the disciples doubt in Luke 24:36-37, Jesus comes and offers them peace. How have you experienced peace from Jesus?

2. In Luke 24:38-43 Jesus goes out of His way to prove to His disciples that He truly has risen physically from the dead. Why do you think Jesus does all of this? And why is it important?

3. In Luke 24:44-45 Jesus opens the minds of the disciples to understand the Scripture. Why is prayer so important to our Bible reading? Why are we prone to not always do this?

4. Jesus reveals the heart of the gospel in Luke 24:46-47. With Easter coming up this week, how can we keep this good news fresh in our minds?

5. Jesus gives His disciples a commission in verses 47-49. How can knowing we are clothed with power from power from on high change the way we are witness for Christ?

6. In verses 50-53 Jesus ascends into heaven. How do the disciples react to this ascension? Why do they react in this way? What can we learn from this?

7. How can you worship Jesus with great joy and bless the Lord continually in the coming week?
