SERMON QUESTIONS

1. What might be some reasons in the text to think Paul is describing his life as a Christian in Romans 7:13-25? What might be some reasons in the text to think that Paul is describing his life before he knew Christ? Where do you land on the interpretation issue?

2. Assuming Paul is describing the struggle of the Christian life in Romans 7, what evidence do you see of this struggle in your own life? In what ways can you relate to Paul's description of the Christian life?

3. Why is it important for Christians to realize they will not reach a state of perfection in this life?

4. If both Christians and non-Christians sometimes struggle with sin, what is it about the struggle of a Christian against sin that is different than the struggles of a non-Christian?

5. What would be some signs that a person is truly battling against sin? Do you see these signs in your own life? If so, what does the battle look like for you?

6. In Romans 7, Paul speaks of nothing good dwelling in his flesh (v. 18). What is the flesh and how do we avoid operating out of the flesh?

7. How can we actively fight against sin using the power that God has given us? What does this look like on a practical level?

8. As Christians how do we fight against sin currently while also recognizing that our future deliverance is still to come (cf. vv. 24-25)?

9. What is one practical step you want to take this week in response to reading this passage?
