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SERMON QUESTIONS

1. How would you define the word "mercy"? Why is it critical for us to understand the merciful nature of God?
2. What is the significance of God's mercy extending to both Jews and Gentiles? What difference does this make for us?
3. Why is it noteworthy that Paul would appeal to the OT in vv. 25-26 and vv. 27-29 to make the argument that both Gentiles and a remnant of Israel are to be included in God's people?
4. In what ways is God's mercy at the heart of the gospel message? What would we be missing about the gospel if we did not see God's mercy at its heart?
5. In what ways does the language of v. 29 parallel our own story? Why is it so important for us to understand what our fate would have been if not for God's intervention and mercy?
6. Think about the language used in vv. 25-26. Why is it so shocking (and encouraging) that those in the church would now be called "his people" and his "beloved" and "sons of the living God"?
7. As you think about the mercy of God and a passage like this one, what should be our response? How do you want to live differently this week in light of reading this passage?
