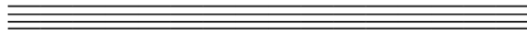

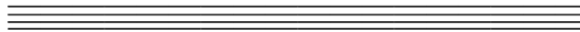

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SERMON QUESTIONS

1. As you think about the context of Romans 10 as a whole, how do vv. 14-21 fit into that overall context?
2. Why does Paul remind us that not everyone responds to the gospel message (cf. v. 16, 21)? How does this change the way we think about the task of proclaiming Christ?
3. Why is the verbal proclamation of the gospel necessary for people to be saved? What implications does this have for us as we think about missions, evangelism and discipleship?
4. In v. 17, Paul says that faith comes from hearing and hearing through the word of Christ. Why is that last line (the word of Christ) so significant?
5. Why do you think so many churches get distracted and stop preaching the word of Christ? How can we guard against this happening at our church?
6. Why is it important for us to urge people to respond to the gospel message? What do you think that looks like practically?
7. As you think about missions and evangelism, what is the number one thing that holds you back from being more engaged? With the help of the Holy Spirit, how do you think you could overcome that obstacle?
8. What is one practical step you want to take this week in response to reading this passage?
